'Aim to use political and social means of action to achieve change in society'



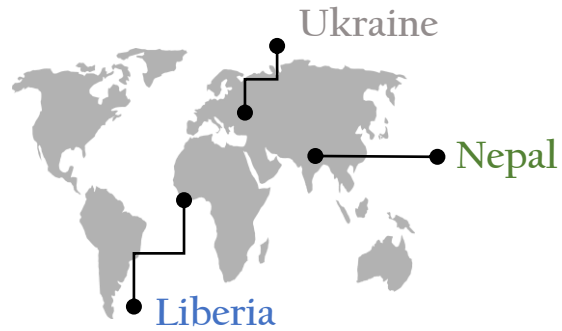
Passive

'Lack of will to do anything for change, prefer to focus on personal affairs'

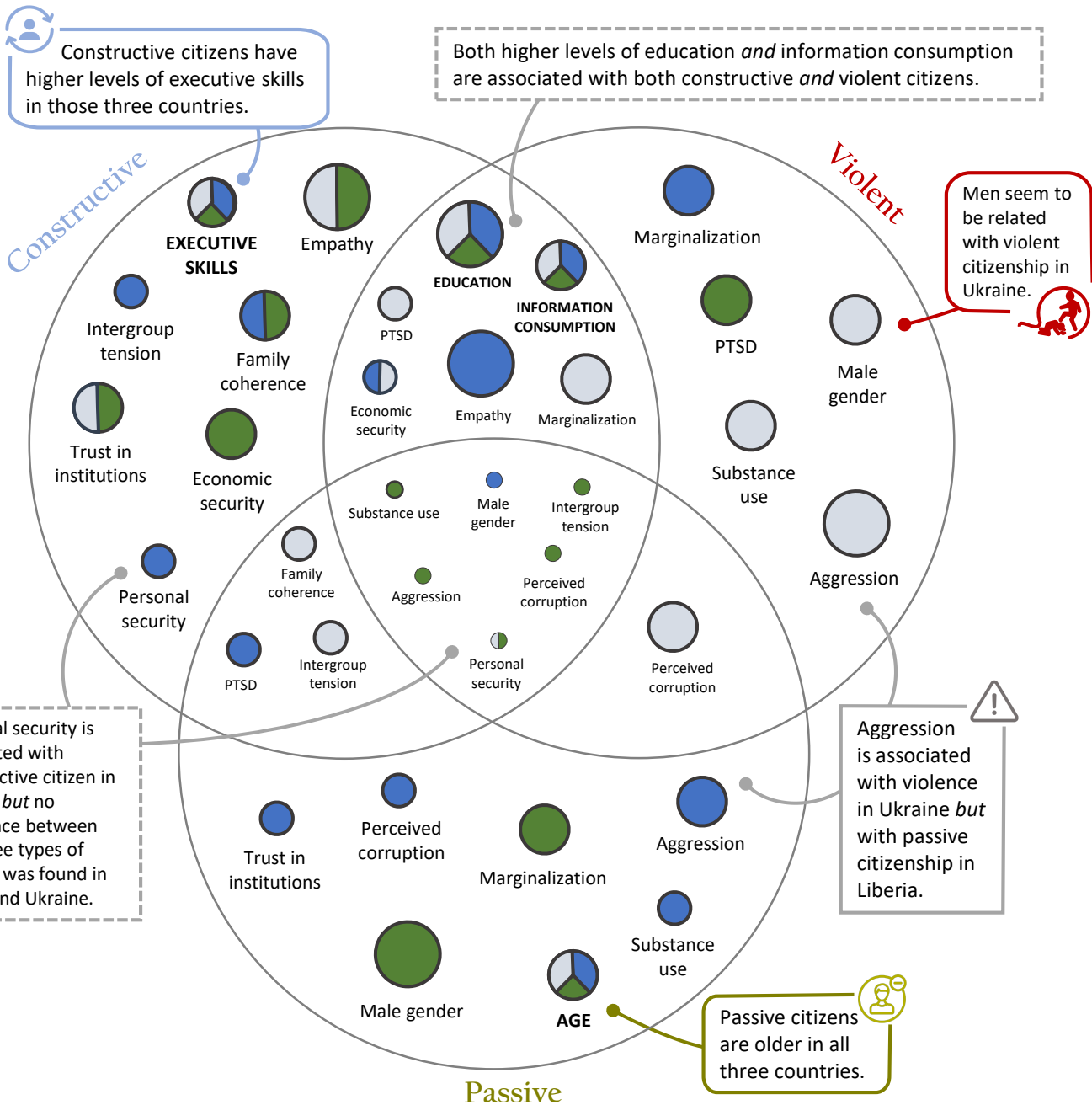


Violent
